

Terms and Conditions Ashland Theatre Tour

Tour Price: A deposit of \$500 reserves your place by the preliminary deposit deadline of May 15, 2009. The balance is due no later than July 1, 2009. Checks should be payable to "New York Theatre Tour," and should be mailed to New York Theatre Tour, 373 Coventry Road, Kensington, CA 94707.

Summary of Features Included in the Tour Price:

Coaching to and from Ashland; best seating for five performances to be selected by tour leader; 5 nights double-occupancy hotel accommodations; hotel portage for one piece of luggage per traveler; buffet breakfast daily; lunch *en route* to and from Ashland; dinner on evening of arrival; farewell dinner on final day; sightseeing day trip or additional sixth play, by individual choice; backstage tour; theatre discussion; travel cancellation insurance. Not included in the tour package: Transportation to or from points of coach embarkation; meals in Ashland not here specified; items of a personal nature, such as telephone, laundry, etc. In the unlikely event that a minimum group of 25 participants is not achieved, tour operator reserves the right to pro-rate an additional charge to cover group expenses.

Cancellation Schedule and Penalties: Deposit, less \$50 service charge, is refundable up to registration deadline, May 15, 2009; cancellation between May 15 and June 30, 2009 will result in forfeiture of deposit. Cancellation after June 30, 2009 will result in forfeiture of entire tour cost. Cancellation must be made in writing and received by tour leader no later than above-referenced dates. Certified mail is required for proof of delivery. Because trip cancellation insurance is included in your tour price, cancellation due to covered causes, less the policy premium (\$126 double occupancy; \$151 single) will be assumed by your insurance. You will be provided a copy of the insurance certificate with your confirmation letter.

(travel agent), act only as agents for suppliers of services (coaching, hotel accommodations, theatres, tours, etc.) in conjunction with this tour, and therefore shall not be responsible for any damage, injury or loss resulting from any cause or by reason or any event beyond the control of the tour leaders or travel agent. Nor shall tour leader or travel agent be held responsible for breach of contract or any careless or intentional actions or omissions on the part of any such suppliers. Tour leader or travel agent shall not be responsible for injuries, damages or losses caused to the traveler in connection with terrorism, strikes, social unrest, governmental actions, mechanical or construction difficulties, disease, climatic conditions, natural disasters, bankruptcies, or any other developments, actions, conditions or omissions outside the control of the travel agent or tour leader.
